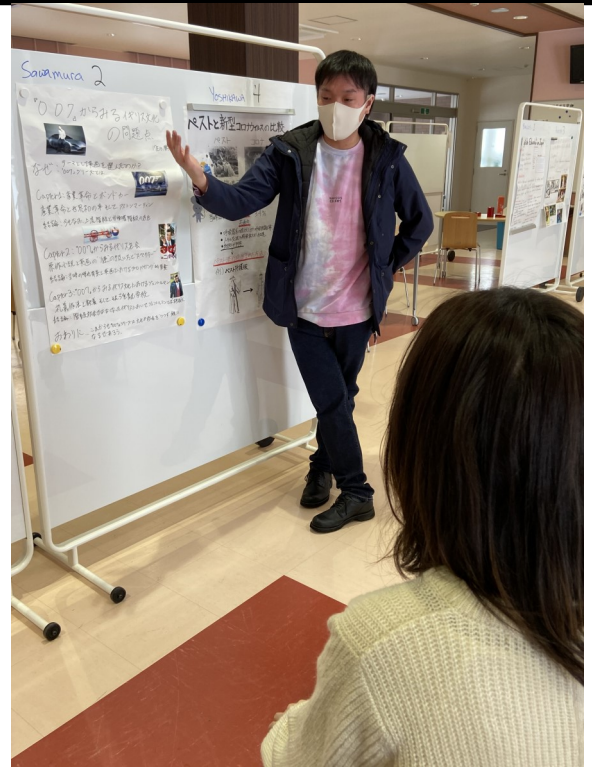
Graduate Thesis Poster

Presentations

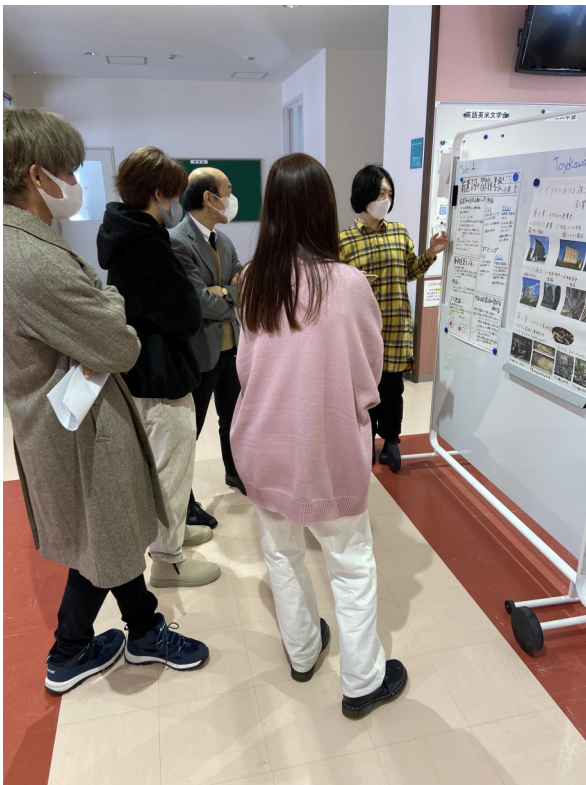
The senior thesis poster session was held on January 30th. The English department seniors gathered in the Learning Commons on campus to share their graduation thesis research. This year a wide range of theses were presented covering topics from historical architecture, to functions of prepositions, to the lessons that can be learned from the plague during the Corona virus pandemic.

Seniors each had seven minutes to explain their research, and answer any questions. This year the seniors presented their findings in both English and Japanese, taking questions in either language.
